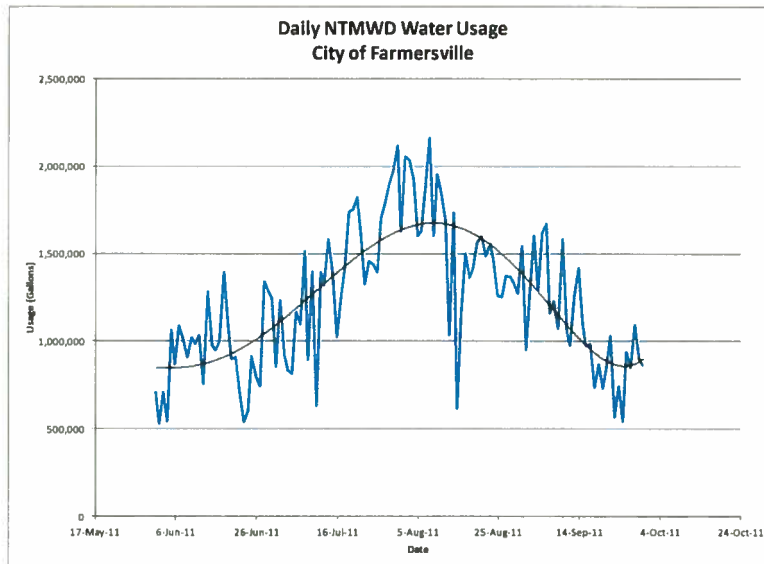

Street System

1. Preliminary Engineering Plan for Street System, Storm Water System, Water System, and Waste Water System on track for completion in October. A plan debrief is tentatively planned for Council on 8 Nov 2011.
2. School Zone signs planned for replacement by the end of October to meet Nov 1st implementation date.
3. Planter in front of Public Safety Building planned for removal in October.
4. Methodist Church parking lot stops installed as agreed.
5. Engineering work started on Safe Routes to School Project. Surveying being performed.

Water System

1. Dry conditions resulting in many line breaks during the month. Mostly old 2" galvanized.
2. US380 Phase III water and sewer line relocation work has started. Aerial crossing near Hendricks Mobile Home Park first on the list.
3. Serious water balance work started on the system to support the delivery of the 2010 Water Conservation Annual Report. Plan to start water balance for more current months in the next weeks. This lays a basis for a water conservation plan that is relevant to our community.
4. Worked with **full-time** Fire Chief Morris on meeting our ISO requirements for fire hydrant marking. We chose to be compliant with the NFPA requirements and will start painting fire hydrants silver with appropriate color coded bonnets.
5. Planning transfer of all Customers currently using NTMWD water on Audie Murphy Parkway West (US 380) to City of Farmersville.
6. Engineering 6 inch waterline extension for Caddo Park. DBI turned on for engineering. This project will be reimbursed by the Army Corps of Engineers.

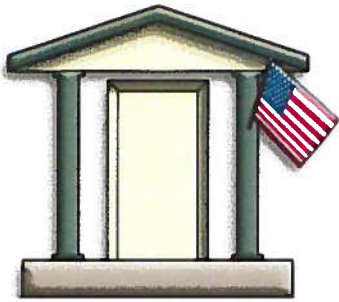
