Concealed Handgun Licensees	The City may exclude any information about concealed handgun licensees.	This information must be withheld under section 411.192 of the Texas Government Code.
Criminal History Information	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The City may exclude results of checks for criminal history record information maintained in state and local criminal history record information systems. The City may exclude compilations of an individual's criminal history. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> This information is confidential pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 20.21(c)(1). This information is confidential pursuant to <i>Open Records Decision No. 565 (1990)</i> (citing <i>United States Dep't of Justice v. Reporters Comm. for Freedom of the Press</i>, 489 U.S. 749 (1989)).
Dates of Birth	The City may exclude dates of birth.	This information is confidential pursuant to the doctrine of Common Law Privacy. See <i>Atty Gen. of Tex. v. City of Dallas</i> , No. 03-13-09546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061 (Tex. App.).
Juvenile Records	The City may exclude any juvenile law enforcement records.	This information must be withheld under section 58.007 of the Texas Family Code and former section 51.14 of the Texas Family Code.
Medical Information	The City may exclude medical records information taken from medical records, confidential medical information, and information disclosing a mental illness.	This information is confidential pursuant to section 159.002 of the Texas Occupations Code, Section 159.002 and the doctrine of Common Law Privacy.
Motor Vehicle Records	The City may exclude confidential driver's license and motor vehicle information.	This information is confidential pursuant to section 552.130 of the Texas Government Code.
Personal Financial Information	The City may exclude any individual's personal financial information.	<p>This information is confidential pursuant to the doctrine of Common Law Privacy.</p> <p>Note: Personal financial information does not include salary or government-paid benefits of a public employee. Information about salary and government-paid benefits is not being excluded.</p>
Personal Information of Public Employees	The City may exclude the home address, telephone number, family member information, and emergency contact information of any peace officer and of any public employee who is not a peace officer who made an election to keep such information confidential prior to the date the City received my request. The City may exclude public employee dates of birth.	This information must be withheld under section 552.117 of the Texas Government Code and <i>Tex. Comptroller of Pub. Accounts v. Atty Gen. of Tex.</i> , 2010 WL 4910163 (Tex. Dec. 3, 2010).
Police and Fire Fighter Records	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The City may exclude portions of the departmental personnel file of a police officer or fire fighter. The departmental personnel file contains information regarding investigations of job-related misconduct by a police officer or fire fighter that did not result in disciplinary action under chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code. The City may exclude the name and badge number of undercover officers when disclosure of the information would subject the officer to a substantial threat of physical harm. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> This information is confidential pursuant to section 143.089(g) of the Texas Local Government Code. This information must be withheld under section 552.117 of the Texas Government Code.
Polygraph Examination	The City may exclude information obtained as a result of a Polygraph Examination.	This information is confidential pursuant to section 1702.306 of the Texas Occupations Code.
Utility Records	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The City may exclude information regarding utility customer usage data, billing, and personal information. The City may exclude utility account numbers. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> This information is confidential pursuant to section 182.052 of the Texas Utilities Code and cannot be released if the utility customer has requested that the government-operated utility keep the information confidential. This information is confidential pursuant to section 552.136 of the Texas Government Code.
Victims of Sexual Assault/Harassment	The City may exclude any records concerning the identity of victims of sexual assault or sexual harassment and other information that would identify the victim, including addresses and names of relatives.	This information is confidential pursuant to the doctrine of Common Law Privacy.
