

All About Farmersville Main Street Program

Downtown revitalization through historic preservation, with an emphasis on four areas:

Design

- Architectural design assistance for building owners
- Downtown beautification including plants, benches, sidewalk, lighting, window displays
- Building maintenance information for owners of historic buildings



In the 1920s, Farmersville was known as an onion growing capital. Main Street coordinated the restoration of the historic Onion Shed, which is now used for many community events including the monthly Farmers & Fleas Market



Promotion

- Annual Audie Murphy Day in June honors local veterans and hometown hero Audie Murphy
- Farmers & Fleas Market held first Saturday of month at the Onion Shed.
- Downtown Shopping Guides
- Partnering with Chamber, City, and Downtown Merchants for cooperative Marketing and collaborative activities
- There are over 50 buildings listed on the Farmersville National Register Commercial District.



Economic Restructuring

- Promoting heritage tourism and encouraging reinvestment in historic preservation
- Small business skills information and seminars for local business owners
- Over \$13.7 million invested in our downtown since the year 2000
