**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE, TEXAS CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 6, 2017 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE COUNCILMEMBERS, PLACES 1, 3 AND 5, OF THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE, TEXAS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmersville, Texas, ("City Council"), issued an order on January 24, 2017, directing that a general municipal election be held on May 6, 2017, for the purpose of electing three officials of the City to serve as Place 1, Place 3 and Place 5 City Council Members; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of election was properly given by the City as required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered the returns of said election held May 6, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, said election was duly and legally held on May 6, 2017 in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said election have been certified and returned by the proper judge and clerks thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the election returns, duly and legally made, showed that there were cast at said election a total of 451 valid and legal votes, of which 317 votes were cast early and 134 votes were cast on election day, and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

**WHEREAS**, section 67.003 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, generally provides that each local canvassing authority shall convene not later than the eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) day after the election date for the purpose of canvassing the election results; and

**WHEREAS**, section 67.004(a) of the Texas Election Code, as amended, establishes the quorum level required to canvass election results.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERSVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:**

**Section 1: FINDINGS INCORPORATED**

All of the above premises are found to be true and correct factual and legislative determinations of the City of Farmersville and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

**Section 2: EXPRESSION OF ELECTORS**

It is hereby found and determined that the results of the election as canvassed and tabulated in the preamble reflect the expressed desires of the resident qualified electors of the City.

**Section 3: ELECTED COUNCILMEMBER PLACES 1, 3 AND 5**

Pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and the Texas Election Code, the City Council officially finds and determines and declares the results of said election to be that the duly elected Councilmembers of the City Council of the City of Farmersville, Texas, elected May 6, 2017, for Councilmember Places 1, 3 and 5, subject to the taking of the oaths of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas are as follows:
