

**CITY OF FARMERSVILLE
PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD MINUTES
JULY 25, 2016**

The Farmersville Parks and Recreation Board met in regular session on July 25, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall with the following members present: Glenn Bagwill, Suzie Gruzendorf, Kim Potter, Miranda Martin, Cathy Strong and Emily Dillard. CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES
