PUBLIC DECORUM AND DISORDERLY CONDUCT

The Mayor shall ensure that all comments addressed to the body be factual in nature, relative to City business. The Mayor shall require that all persons speaking address the body with respect, decorum and prevent personal and disparaging comments. City Council may not respond to citizen comments except as provided and the Mayor shall ensure that members of the governing body address the public with respect, decorum and prevent personal and disparaging comments. The making of disparaging remarks may rise to the level of disorderly conduct and the person may be removed as allowed by law.

If you wish to address the City Council on a posted item on this agenda, please fill out a "Speaker Sign-Up" card and present it to the City Secretary before the meeting begins. Pursuant to Section 551.007 of the Texas Government Code, any person wishing to address the City Council for items listed as public hearings will be recognized when the public hearing is opened. Speakers wishing to address the City Council regarding any non-public hearing item on this agenda shall have a time limit of up to three (3) minutes per speaker, per agenda item.

The Mayor may reduce the speaker time limit uniformly to accommodate the number of speakers or improve meeting efficiency.


