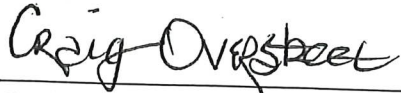

Summary

If the City of Farmersville adopts the proposed tax rate of .725000 per \$100 valuation, the average homestead owner would pay approximately \$86.32 more annually compared to the current year.

***\*\*The 2025 tax year property tax rate listed above as the “2025 Proposed Rate” was adopted on September 23, 2025, and is currently in effect. The information provided above is required by State law. The agenda discussion posted for this meeting is a preliminary discussion regarding projected revenues and expenses necessary to begin and proceed with the preparation of a budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 as required by law. In accordance with State law, information necessary for the City to provide a proposed 2026 tax rate will be available from Collin County Appraisal District (CCAD) on or after July 25, 2026; however, when a proposed budget has been prepared and the City has received the CCAD information necessary to provide a proposed 2026 tax year rate, the table above will be updated with information regarding the 2026 tax year proposed rate, and a proposed budget will be posted online and accessible from the City of Farmersville homepage at <https://www.farmersvilletx.com> .***

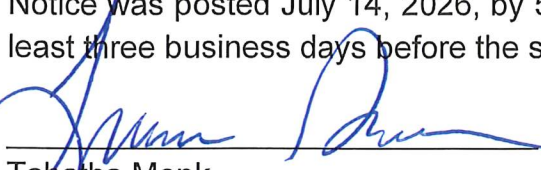
